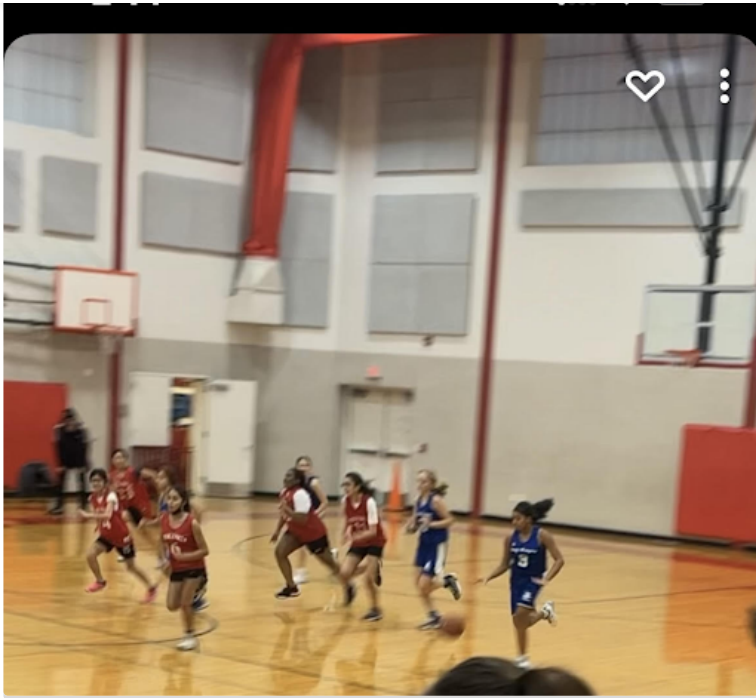

A man was arrested Wednesday in the Muskegon area after he was found with three missing teenage girls from Florida, authorities say. They said the three girls were not forced to go to Muskegon county at all.

So with that, the 24 year old man was arrested after being found with three underaged girls, two 14-year olds and one 15-year old. The girl's parents had said that the three kids were all runaways and that the man never abducted them or forced them to get into the car, The man apparently had lived in Orlando, Florida at the time.

In my opinion, parents and teens need to know how bad and dangerous this can be for teens and kids to get in cars with adults. Even though the man in this story was only 24 years old and these kids were 14 and 15, the teens were in a very dangerous situation and they probably didn't even realize it.

With that I think parents should talk with their kids about meeting people on the internet and how unsafe it is and let their kids know they need to talk to them if they are upset and not just run away.

The teens need to understand that if they want to run away because they are unhappy, they need to talk to their parents or another adult to find a better solution.
