If you see one of our reporters and would like them to report on something of interest to you, please let them know. We hope you enjoy our first newspaper of the 2022-2023 school year.

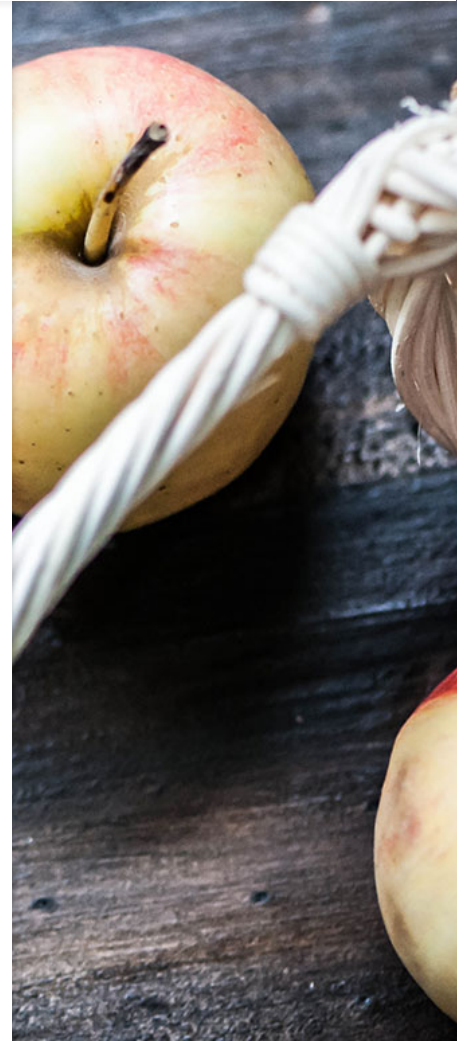

A-Talking to students, sharing things I like. and being there for students.



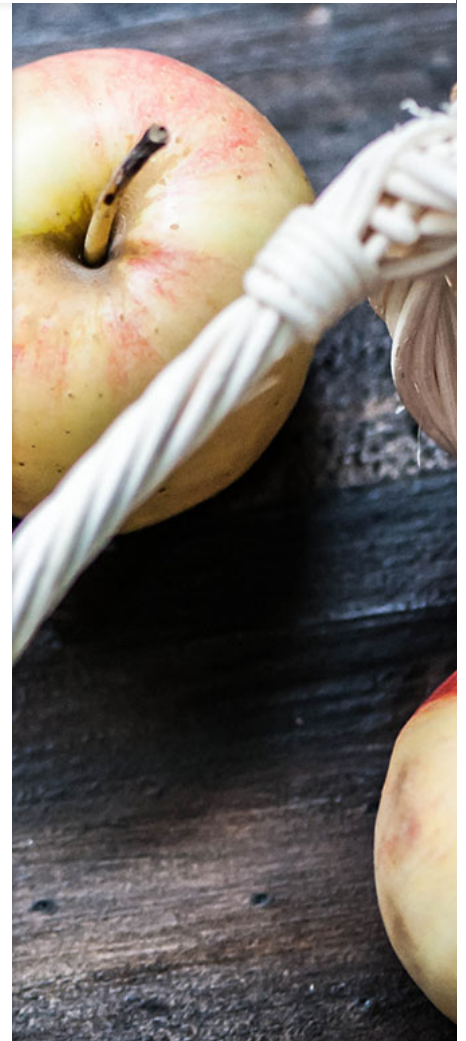

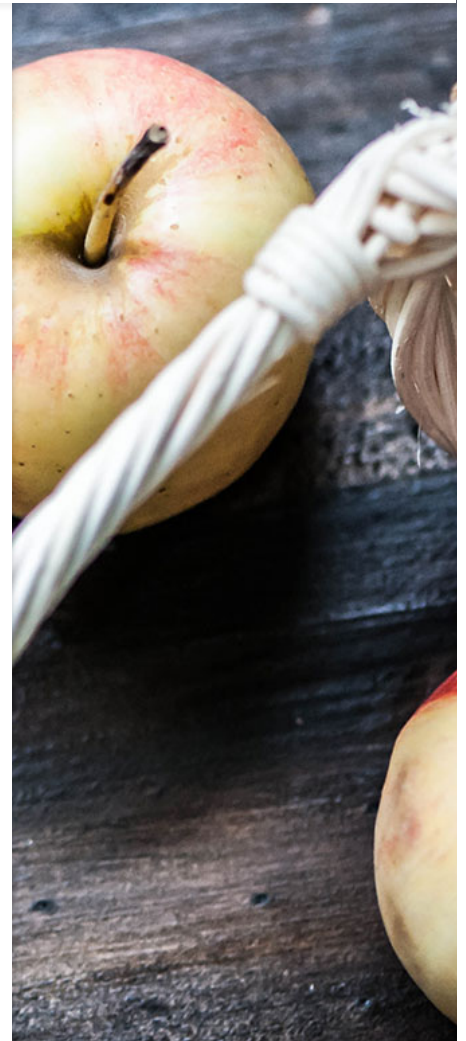

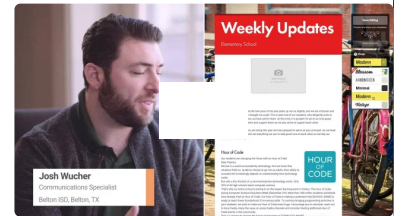
