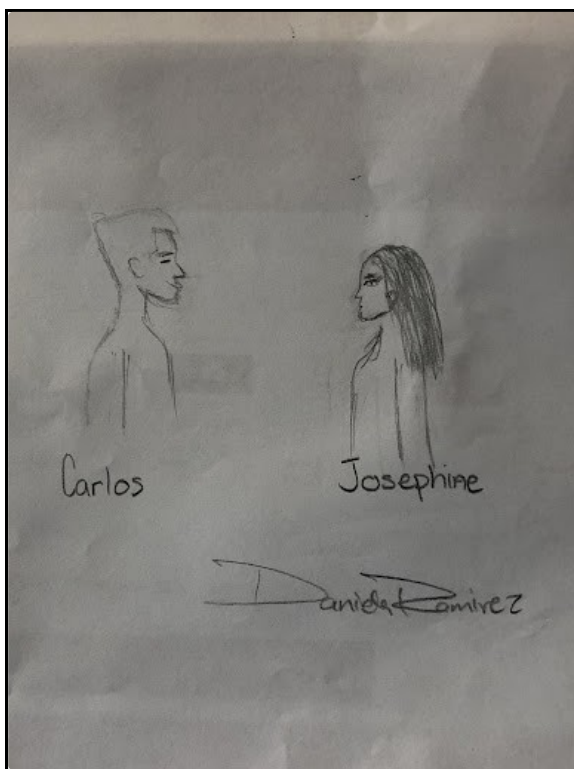

Queen Elizabeth was the Queen of the United Kingdom from February 6, 1952 until her death in 2022. She was Queen Regnant of 32 sovereign states. She lived to be 96 years old before she sadly passed away due to old age. She became the queen on February 6, 1952. She was 25 years old when she became the Queen of the United Kingdom. A couple fun facts about the Queen is that she was the only one in the UK to drive without a license. She had 2 birthdays (first birthday- April 21, 1926 her second birthday- the second Saturday of June in 1926). She had two birthdays because one is her real birthday and the other is her coronation.

If you wanted to meet the Queen face to face you had to do a neck bow for the men, but for the women they had to do a small curtsy. Other people prefer to shake hands like the normal way. But when you meet the queen the correct formal address is "Your Majesty" and "ma'am" but with a short 'a', as in 'jam'.

Now that Queen Elizabeth died King Charles became the King the day that the Queen died. The Queen's actual funeral took place at Westminster Abbey nine days after her death. There are strict rules that they have to follow in order to see who would eventually take over. After Charles's reign, Prince William is next in line to the throne. However those plans do not include an abdication and they remain in the line of succession as do their two children.

Have you ever heard of Tupac Amaru Shakur also known as Tupac? He was an American rapper. He was one of the most influential rappers of all time. Tupac was born June 16, 1971 in Brooklyn, New York. In 1984, 13-year-old Tupac moved to Baltimore with his younger half-sister, Sekyiwa and her father, Mutul Shakur, who was married to Afeni Shakur from 1975 to 1982 . They lived in the first-floor apartment of a brick row house at 3955 Greenmount Avenue in the small North Baltimore neighborhood where he attended Roland Park Middle School for 8th grade.

Tupac's rap career began in early 1991; later that year he released his first song named Same Song, a part of the Underground album. Tupac's first hit song was "I Get Around" 'which first topped the chart in 1993. Tupac is one of the best selling artists. He sold over 75 million copies worldwide . His most sold song is How Do U Want It/California Love.

On September 13, 1996 Tupac was in a drive-by shooting where he died of gunshot wounds. Tupac Amaru was only twenty-five when he passed away with a net worth of 150 Thousand. Even after Tupac Shakur passed away he still remains one of the most recognizable faces and voices in hip-hop.
