A: "If I get any offers I plan on going to college for wrestling but if not I want to go to a trade school and become a tradesman"



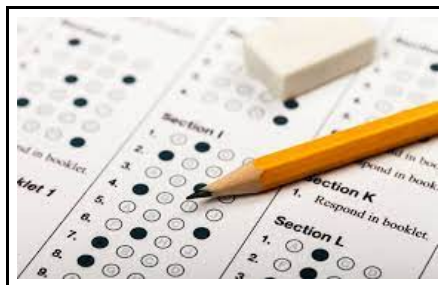

After spring break students will be taking the PSAT. The PSAT is the practice for the SAT for when students get into high school. This is taken to have students prepared once they have to take the SAT. It helps students know what to expect when taking these tests.

The PSAT won't count towards your college admissions applications, but it is a qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship. Some of the highest scoring students may win scholarships or money. Students shouldn't stress about the PSAT but they also shouldn't ignore it either. Students should use the PSAT as a practice for the SAT. It is important for your college admissions.

The average PSAT score is 920. A score between 1210 and 1520 puts you in the top 10% of test takers. The PSAT and the SAT are similar tests so the score you get on the PSAT can give you an idea on what you would get for the SAT.
